Phonics- Rhyming.



1. Find a bowl and a spoon.

Sing the rhyme- I'm making lots of silly soup,

I'm making soup that's silly.

I'm gonna put it in the fridge to keep it nice and chilly.

Think of words to put in the bowl, (you can write them), find pictures. Get the children to draw the pictures or you can draw them. If you have access to a printer you can find rhyming pictures on twinkl. Search rhyming words. The children just need to hear that the words sound the same.

2. Create a rhyming string- dog, log, frog, bog, cog, mog, nog, ( can be made up words)
3. Rhyming stories- Julia Donaldson stories, Hairy Maclary stories. I will read some of these and post them on the Penhale Facebook page.
4. Sing nursery rhymes- change the rhyming words- Humpty Dumpty sat on a seat, Humpty Dumpty had smelly feet! The sillier the better.
5. You say a word and your child has to say a word that rhymes  
E.g. you say cat, they say bat.
6. I spy with my rhyming eye something that rhymes with....



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
