

Important Update – Friday 22nd May

Dear parent / carer,

Thank you for your continued engagement as we update you on this rapidly changing situation we are currently in.

As you know we have been working to achieve the Government's ambition to re-open schools from the 1st June and have made good progress towards this and are pleased with the high levels of support & understanding from parents and teachers alike.

I wrote to the parents of Nursery and Reception children to inform them that following stakeholder consultation (including teachers, unions and parents) we have decided to **delay to our proposed return to school based learning**. We are now aiming for a return date **no earlier than 8th June** for these children.

Key Workers & distance learning

I wanted to inform you that there is **no change to the arrangements for the children of Key Workers or vulnerable students outlined in my letter sent earlier this week**. If you wish to use the Key Worker provision please contact the school office at least 24 hours in advance.

Our current distance learning resources will continue again from 1st June.


There are no changes to arrangements shared earlier this week.
